MESSAGE FROM RABBINIC INTERN ANNA BURKE:

This week, we once again begin the cycle of reading the Torah from start to finish as we read the creation stories of *Parashat B'reishit*. That's right: the Torah offers two narratives of creation. We first read the story of the six days of creation, which includes the creation of the first humans. We then read the story of Adam and Eve, which tells a different story about the creation of humanity. How can the Torah offer these two different versions of creation? Which one is true? Is either true?

The truth is that I do not have the answers to all of these questions. What I do know, however, is that the Torah teaches us something interesting about stories and narratives. B'reishit teaches us that multiple narratives are always present, even on issues that are so fundamental to our understanding of the world. We have our own truths, values, and narratives, and yet we are forced to reckon with the fact that other humans have ones that are different from and opposed to ours. We must grapple not just with which ideas are right and which are wrong, but the notion that there is value in having multiple perspectives. I believe that we have something to learn from hearing alternative viewpoints and narratives, even when we feel so strongly about our own thoughts and ideas. I want to live in a world where I learn from others, for if everybody thought like me, what would the world look like? What would I have to learn?

As I prepare to join Congregation Anshe Emeth next week for Shabbat, I am particularly excited to learn from each of you in our text study and hear your stories and perspectives. I look forward to embracing the beautiful pluralism and diversity we each bring to our Jewish community. Shabbat Shalom.
